let alone**

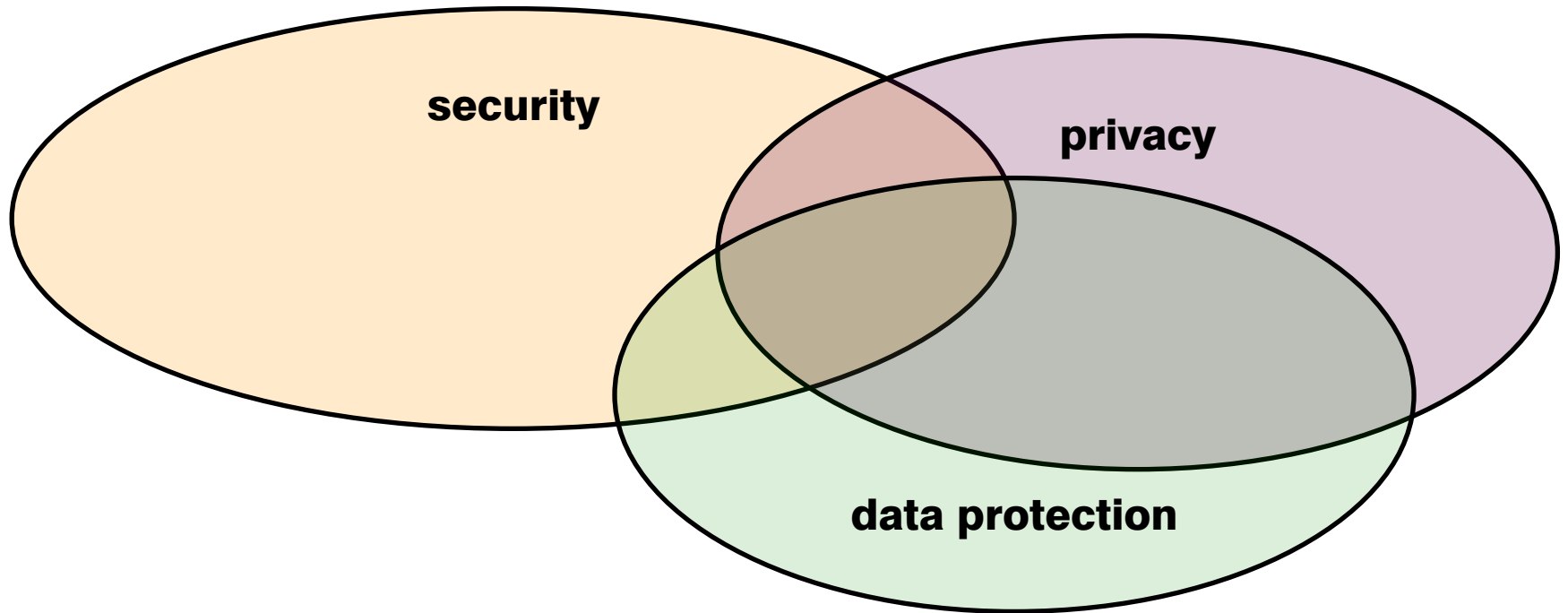
**informational privacy /
